- Advance reservations of one week required. No last minute reservation will be accepted.
- Registrations are not confirmed until receipt of payment. Payment may be made by cash, check, or credit card. There is a \$10 minimum for credit card purchases.
- No refunds will be given to participants not attending on their scheduled date unless reservations are cancelled at least one week in advance.
- AMSE reserves the right to cancel a program in the event that a minimum capacity is not reached. In this event 100% of registration fees will be refunded.
- Program fees include fee for program and admission for one student and one adult into the American Museum of Science and Energy if the program is held at the museum. Any siblings accompanying the student and parent will have to pay regular admission into the museum.
